



Brazilian Chalk Walk Contest

During the Global Oklahoma Festival
Saturday, Oct. 1, 2011, at Rose State College

Artists of all ages are invited to participate in the Brazilian Chalk Walk Contest at Global Oklahoma on the campus of Rose State College on October 1. Global Oklahoma is a festival of cultures with food, entertainment, exhibits, and activities for all ages. The theme of the contest is Brazil, in honor of the featured country.

Criteria:

The Brazilian Chalk Walk Contest will feature four categories in which the artists may compete: Elementary (grades 3 – 6), Junior High (grades 7 - 9), High School (grades 10 – 12), and College/Adult. Artists can work alone, or in groups of up to four for each section of drawing space. Drawing spaces are about 4x4' each. Artists are encouraged to incorporate a lot of color into their drawing in celebration of the Brazilian theme. Suggestions include flowers, beaches, carnivals, and animal-themed drawings. Rose State College will provide refreshments and the chalk, but artists may also bring their own chalk.

Entries:

The contest is free to enter. Registration in advance is due by Sept. 27, and registration will also be open at the festival from 8-9 a.m. On the day of the contest, artists will be given two cards: one to fill out and hand in for our records, the other to place by the chalk drawing. The card must have all artists names who are working on that square. (Limit four people per drawing space). If a group or school wants all of their artists in one location, please let us know during registration. Register in advance by calling Festival Director: Lisa Price at (405) 736-0313. Registration on contest day is at the contest site by the Gym.

- Artists can start drawing at 9 a.m. Judging will begin at 1 p.m.
- Judges are Fernando Padilla, Skip Hill, Patrick Riley, and Bobby Marsee.

Prizes:

A "Best of Show" ribbon will be presented to a winner in each category. All winners will be recognized with a press release and pictures published on the Global Oklahoma web page following the festival.
